- Continue to implement the established practices, protocols and processes associated with the utilization of BMTs to reduce student discipline referrals and address problematic for each grade level and for each month.
- Support a 15-20% increase in parent engagement as measured quarterly by accuracy of parent communication and presence/participation for the Latin X population through targeted and intentional measures.
- Create an onboarding process that supports freshmen in their transition from middle school to high school while providing the scaffolding needed to ensure they remain with their cohort and increase the current GHS graduation percentage of 86%.
- Continue to provide needed resources and support for staff to meet the needs of students to underpin increased growth and proficiency by 30% in EOC Courses: Math 1, Biology, Math 3 and English 2.
