YMCA Before/After School Academy Quick Fact Sheet (The Downtown School)

Q: Does the Y provide before or after-school care at Downtown Elementary?

Yes, The YMCA provides Before School Care beginning at 6:30am and after school care from the time school is dismissed until 6pm.

Q: Will students be bused to the YMCA after school?

No, all students will remain on campus at the end of the school day.

Q: Does the YMCA provide care on early dismissal days? Inclement weather?

In the event of an early dismissal, whether it is scheduled or unscheduled, the Y will provide care on-site at Downtown Elementary School.

In the event the school is closed for inclement weather, the Y will provide care at the William G. White Jr. Family YMCA

Q: What is the cost and commitment of the before and after school program?

Families have several options for frequency and cost of care.

- Before school care ONLY: \$70/Members and \$80/Potential Members per month
- After School care ONLY: \$260/Members and \$310/Potential Members per month (5 days a week); \$230/Members and \$265/Potential Members per month (3 days a week)

Q: Are there discounts/drop in options offered for families?

Yes, financial assistance is available through our Open Doors program. Additionally, the Y offers sibling discounts and military/first responder discounts. The Y will also offer drop-in services for families.

Q: Will a snack be provided during the program?

Yes. The YMCA will provide a snack for participants in the program.
