## **Admission Requirements**

- ◆ Possess a high degree of motivation and commitment to be an advocate for best educational practices for students with disabilities.
- ◆ Bachelor of Science (BS) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree from a regionally accredited college or university
- ◆ Cumulative grade point average of 2.80 or higher from the undergraduate/graduate degree-granting institution
- ◆ Complete all NCA&T graduate school admissions procedures:
  - 1) Criminal background check from county of residency
  - 2) Graduate College Application
  - 3) Official transcripts from all colleges and/or universities attended
  - 4) Three Letters of recommendation
  - 5) Written personal statement of intent
  - 6) Application fee

## **Additional Requirements**

- ◆ May currently hold a position in local school district working with students with and without disabilities but may not hold a clear teaching license
- ◆ Lateral entry teachers may apply
- ◆ Must have a position in a special education classroom while in the program
- ◆ Must commit to teach special education according to agreement to receive funding. (Based on federal guidelines)
