



AP FRENCH – LANGUAGE AND CULTURE

Description

This course is designed for the highly motivated 4th or 5th year student (sophomore, junior, or senior), to increase proficiency in listening to, reading, writing, and speaking French at the third year college (intermediate/advanced) level. At the end of the course, students should be able to: (1) comprehend formal and informal French from many Francophone cultures; (2) analyze and speak about a variety of topics with fluency; (3) read and synthesize a variety of authentic cultural texts; and (4) write informal correspondence and formal essays in French. It is expected that students will work independently on vocabulary and grammar development and their performance skills.
