



AP JAPANESE –LANGUAGE & CULTURE

Description

This course prepares students to demonstrate their level of Japanese proficiency across the three communicative modes: interpretive, interpersonal, and presentational. Students will learn to develop effective communication in Japanese, understand Japanese culture and be prepared to participate in a global society. Culture will be integrated in the interpersonal learning of each unit.
