Description

Survey of microeconomic theory. The course teaches how to evaluate different types of markets and businesses in these markets. Topics include perfect competition, monopolistic competition, oligopoly, and monopoly. The nature of the course entails logical thinking.

This is a first semester course.

Special requirements

The course consists of readings, working out problem sets, tests, essays, and projects.

Use of graphs, charts and data analysis

Successful students will have a strong foundation in honors and upper level mathematics courses.

Student costs/Materials to be supplied by students

Minimal costs (less than \$20) will be incurred in the course.

Other information

Certain projects may require additional evening/weekend work.

Students may receive college credit for this course by taking the Advanced Placement Examination and earning a score acceptable to their college. This acceptable score varies from school to school and department to department.
