



AP SPANISH – LANGUAGE & CULTURE

Description

This course is designed for the highly motivated 4th or 5th year student (sophomore, junior and senior) to develop language proficiency in writing, speaking, listening, and reading Spanish (3rd year college intermediate/pre-advanced levels). In this course students will learn how to communicate with fluency and accuracy in a variety of authentic contexts and situations. The course will also help using grammar in context, developing critical thinking skills, and building cultural understanding of various Spanish speaking countries. It is expected that students work independently on vocabulary, grammar development, and their proficiency skills.

Prerequisite: Spanish III

- AP Spanish Practice Manual (approximately \$25) with cd's from Barron's or Princeton Publishers (recommended)

Students may receive college credit for this course by taking the Advanced Placement Examination and earning a score acceptable to their college. This acceptable score varies from school to school and department to department.
