



GERMAN III HONORS

Description

Thorough review of vocabulary, grammar, and cultural knowledge from German I and II, and conclusion of major German grammar concepts. Learn about German culture from written and spoken texts. Learn to express feelings, thoughts, and opinions in writing and in conversation. Work independently on several projects connecting with other subject areas and personal interests.

Special requirements

Prerequisite: German II

A grade of "C" or above in German II is recommended. Teacher consultation suggested.

Must be willing to be challenged in all 4 language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing.

This is an honors course and depends on conscientious execution of assignments.

Student costs/Materials to be supplied by students

Access to a computer and the Internet

A German college dictionary with at least 120,000 entries if a cellphone with Internet access is not available.

This course is taught in German, except where difficult grammar rules are explained.
