Reading and listening to authentic German texts covering the six major topics: contemporary life, families and communities, personal and public identities, beauty and aesthetics, global challenges, and science and technology. Doing several research projects in a field of interest and on current events.

Special requirements

Prerequisite: German III

A grade of "C" or above in German III is recommended.

Must be able to read and write independently.

Must be competent to speak freely and to understand quickly in class discussions.
