<u>Tallying NHS Folder points You will Not Receive Points for Anything Submitted without a signature!!!!</u> Plan ahead and get signatures early.

2 points per:

- year of service club participation
- season of school or non-school sports participation
- season of cheerleading (if only for one sport) because it is a sport and all sports count 2 points per season
- season of play on the Academic Team (One team only... you don't get double the points if you play on two teams)
- season of being a Wrestlerette or Manager of a sport with coach recommendation
- Participation in a non-grade based play or production on or off campus
- Season of marching band

1 point per:

- year of club participation
- individual honor
- 3 months of part-time work (up to 25 hours a week)
- one month of full-time work (25 or more hours weekly)
- leadership role involving supervision of peers (may include Section Leader in music class, Section Editor in journalism or yearbook)
- coaching or tutoring younger students (role model)
- Crosby Scholars or any volunteer work

NO POINTS FOR:

- Any honor or award based on GPA (Academic letter, honor roll, Straight A's, Junior Marshal etc.)
- Homecoming Court, Prom Queen/King
- Other Honor Societies (Nat'l Vocational-Technical, Latin, International Thespians, Beta Club, French National Honor Society.)
- Athletic letter(s)/star(s), Varsity Club
- Work performed for **course credit** in journalism, yearbook, service unit, band, chorus, or JROTC
- Life Skills projects
- Perfect Attendance Awards
- Activities that have not yet occurred/been done
- PTSA membership or It's My Call participation
- Charitable donations
- One-time charity events
- Worship service or regular Sunday School attendance
