## **Painting of Senior Parking Spaces**

**2021-2022**

This year RJR Senior student drivers will have the opportunity to paint/personalize a parking space on campus. The paint/personalized parking spaces will be an additional \$20 to the cost of the 2021-2022 parking permit.

**The Painting Party will be Tuesday November 23 from 11:00pm-2:00pm .**

A Reserved Painted Parking Space Student Contract must be approved before painting.

### **Guidelines for your Design Sketch:**

Think of your spaces as a T-Shirt you would wear to school. Your Parking spot must meet dress code approval. Keep it classy! Students can't use designs associated with gangs, advertising drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene slogans, handicap symbols or symbols that cause confusion or promote illegal activities will not be allowed nor approved. You may include name, jersey number, instruments you play, your hobby, famous quotes or slogans and anything unique to you that meets administrative approval. Make it fun!

### **Painting Requirements**

- **PAINT MUST BE WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX**
- **Do not** cover the yellow lines, front curb/bumper block, or number of the parking space.
- Students must leave 4 inches between the yellow lines and the design. It is advisable to tape this border off prior to painting. It takes about 2 gallons if you want to do a base coat before painting your design. Old paint works really well also.
- **No** spray, fluorescent, reflective, glitter, oil based, or other types of paint allowed
- **No** offensive language, pictures, flags, or symbols.
- **No** negative or rude language.
- **No** symbols related to gang-activity or gang-style tagging.
- **No** double meanings, nicknames, girlfriend/boyfriend names, etc. Only your own name will be allowed.
- **No** use of names belonging to other students. Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration and you will forfeit your right to a parking space. Your money will not be refunded.

## Additional Items to You Need to Bring to the Paint Party

- Chalk to sketch your design first
- Paint brushes and/or paint rollers- try to use a roller with extension handles for the base coat.
- Paint roller extension
- Paint pans or plastic containers for water, brushes, and paint and wooden stirrers
- Blue painter's tape, 4 inches wide to mark off spot
- Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans (remember paint can't be erased)
- Broom to sweep spot
- Old cloths or paper towels
- A bag for your trash
- Sunshade, sunscreen, umbrellas, sunglasses, hats, Water, snacks
- Lawn chairs, stool, towels to sit on People to help you!

**I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking space:**


1. Upon purchasing my parking space, I will only use water-based exterior paint.
2. I understand that I must check in at the student parking lot before I begin painting.
3. I know that I am not allowed to use spray, fluorescent, reflective, glitter, or oil based paint.
4. I will only paint within the marked parking space, leaving a 4 inch space between the white lines.
5. I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my space.
6. I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space.
7. I will only paint my approved design following all of the guidelines. I will not add anything to my parking space after painting day.
8. If I do not abide by these rules, I realize my parking space will be taken away, painted over, and I will not receive a refund.
9. If I park in someone else's painted parking space, I will receive disciplinary action.
10. I agree to paint over my design using **black water based exterior latex paint** at the end of the year, or pay a fine of \$15.

Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using in your parking space. **No changes can be made on painting day. We will keep a copy of your drawing, so make a copy for yourself.**

**\*Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive an email or call ONLY if your design is unacceptable, or if any changes need to be made.**

**On painting day, you will:**

**1. Bring your copy of your design.**

2. A receipt showing that you have paid for the Painting Privileges and your spot number.

3. A form of ID

4. Newspaper, tarp, tape, or something to block off the rest of the parking space so paint will not get on anything other than your designated space.

5. A broom to sweep your space before you begin painting.

6. Paint brushes, paint, painter's tape, a bucket of water, or any other supplies that you might need.

**Spaces will be the student's personal parking space until the end of the year at which time you will paint over your space with BLACK WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT. Students must supply their own paint . Spaces must be painted over prior to graduation or incur a \$15 fine.**
