To Volunteer

To sign up to be a Reading Warriors tutor, follow the steps below.

- Go to wsfcsvolunteers.com to fill out a volunteer application to be eligible to volunteer in WS/FCS.
- Select a Reading Warriors participating school using the "School or Group" drop-down menu.
- Fill out the rest of the form and chose "Project Impact: Reading Warriors" at the bottom of the form.
- Once you submit your application and are approved to volunteer, someone from Project Impact will contact you with further information and instructions.

As a Reading Warrior, you'll be part of an all-in community effort to close the childhood literacy achievement gap.

The Goal: 90% by 2025, or in other words ensure 90% of first grade students reach grade-level proficiency by the end of third grade in 2025.

The Battle Plan: Reading Warriors volunteers, like you, are a major component of our efforts to succeed. You, along with great quality classroom instruction, support and interventions in school, and increased wraparound services for students, will give our students the backing they need.

The Details: You'll tutor either a kindergartener or first grader for 30 minutes twice weekly. You select from one of the 19 Reading Warrior schools based on your schedule and times available for tutoring at various schools. Tutors receive 12 hours of in person training. The training is completed over 2 days (6 hours per day).
