

COURSE OF STUDY:

ECF 9th and 10th grade students will take pre-determined courses that satisfy both high school and FTCC graduation requirements.







During the Junior year, ECF students will choose to pursue an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree. Students will begin to have choice in college course selection beginning in their 11th grade year (provided the college courses apply to the A.A. or A.S. degree).

State legislation prevents students from obtaining both the A.A. and A.S. degree. ECF students are limited to no more than 64 total credit hours earned at FTCC.
