WINSTON-SALEM JAYCEES – OUTSTANDING YOUNG LEADER SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Scholarship is based on a student's leadership, impact/involvement on their school and community, service to humanity, and academic achievement - minimum GPA of 3.0
Awards: Some of the local winners become eligible to earn a \$1,000 scholarship from the NC Jaycees.
Deadline: November 6, 2019 Turn application into Mrs. Beale by October 31st.

ACCESS SCHOLARS PROGRAM (APPALACHIAN STATE UNIVERSITY)

Criteria: NC resident, first year – fulltime student, family gross income is at or below the federal poverty line. Students must submit the three essays in their MyMountaineer portal, have two letters of recommendation and complete the résumé.
Awards: Students receive an education at Appalachian debt-free for all four years.
Deadline: Submit the application for admission by November 1, 2019

HISPANIC LEAGUE SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Hispanic students who are current and former ESL/ELL students from Forsyth County; both documented and undocumented students, minimum 2.7 GPA, financial need

Criteria: High School seniors and recent graduates of North Carolina high schools who are of Hispanic/Latino background who will enroll in a degree program at a community college or a college/university and be committed to public service and community development; minimum GPA of 2.5
Awards: \$500 to \$2,500 scholarships

- Criteria: Students who are interested in career fields such as engineering, business management, chemistry, polymer chemistry, forensics, medical fields, international studies, design, apparel, sourcing, fashion, merchandising or retail management---some of the career areas of graduates from the College of Textiles
Apply for fall 2020, first-year admission into a baccalaureate program at NC State by the Early Action deadline, **November 1st**
- Awards: Several scholarships providing \$15,000 per year for four years
- Deadline: Nomination by November 15, 2019

LENOIR-RHYNE TEACHING SCHOLARS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- Criteria: Scholars will be selected on the basis of their potential for academic excellence as a university student and a sincere desire to serve others through a career in teaching; interested students are encouraged to attend #Choose LR event on Saturday, October 26th -register for this event at <http://www.lr.edu/admission/undergraduate/visit>
- Awards: Several scholarships up to \$5,500 per year for four years (along with other scholarships and financial aid)

UNCG TEACHER EDUCATION FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Criteria: Seniors who plan to major in Education (Elementary Education, Middle Grades Education, Special Education, Secondary Education Concentrations) and have at least a 3.8 GPA and minimum SAT score of 1100 (CR + M) or 24 ACT composite

Deadline: Priority given to applications received by January 1, 2019
