The benefits of the Army ROTC scholarship are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full Tuition and fees <u>OR</u> Room and Board (\$5,000 a semester) • Book allowance- \$1200 a year • Monthly Stipend- \$420 a month while in school • Travel reimbursement from home to college (once) • No commitment through the first year (as either a 4-year or a 3-year winner). The application involves the collection of administrative data and the uploading of transcripts. The high school is asked to verify class standing and an athletic coach or ROTC instructor is asked to conduct a physical fitness assessment.
