1. Complete [NC Residency Determination Service \(RDS\)](#) process
2. Identify target colleges/universities and the application platform to be used
  - a. [Naviance](#)
  - b. [Common Application](#)
  - c. [College Foundation of North Carolina](#)
  - d. [Coalition for College Application](#)
  - e. [Common Black College Application](#)

\*Many of these platforms require electronic recommendation submissions. Keep updated record of your recommenders contact information, including email addresses\*

3. Identify early application deadlines
4. Complete the [Recommendation Form](#) and return to your School Counselor
5. Identify need for recommendations
6. Check the [Student Services](#) webpage frequently
  - a. College/University Important Dates
  - b. Titan Scholarship Newsletter
    - i. Review & locate possible opportunities
    - ii. Meet published deadlines
    - iii. Complete the [Request to be considered for a Scholarship](#) form if school endorsements/recommendations required
7. All Seniors will receive the Daily Announcements; if you want to be excluded from these emails, notify Mrs. Antonizzi ([jantinozzi@wsfcs.k12.nc.us](mailto:jantinozzi@wsfcs.k12.nc.us) )
8. Develop an admissions testing plan
  - a. [ACT](#)
  - b. [SAT](#)
9. Request a [Fee Waiver](#) for the ACT or SAT (criteria established by college board/ACT will be followed)

\*Due to the impact of COVID-19, the UNC Board of Governors waived the standardized test requirements for first-year applicants to the 16 [UNC System](#) schools

\*Many universities across the country have changed their test submission policies - check those schools websites for current information

10. Complete the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) application
  - a. Request the [FSA ID](#) now - used as an electronic signature (will need student FSA ID and at least one parent/guardian FSA ID)
  - b. FAFSA can be submitted as early as December 1, 2023
11. Develop plan for engaging military representatives if your intent is to join a branch of the military (Army, Air Force, Marines, Navy, Coast Guard)
  - a. Make plans to take the [ASVAB](#) exam if required
12. Work with your School Counselor and Career Development Coordinator, Mrs. Hayes, to develop plans for employment after graduation
  - a. Many local resources for local employment include [City of Winston Salem](#), [Greater Winston Salem](#), [Forsyth Tech Learn & Earn Apprenticeship](#) programs, etc.
