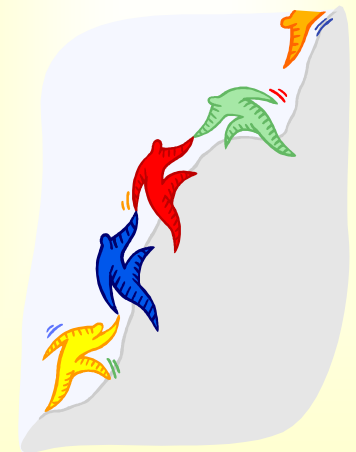

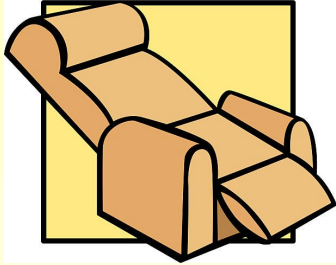

What is the Behavioral Health Urgent Care Center?



Behavioral Health Urgent Care

provides an alternative to Emergency Room and Inpatient Psychiatric Hospitalization for eligible individuals who have a mental illness and/or substance use disorder diagnoses. The unit will be staffed 24-hours-a-day by nurses, licensed clinicians, and certified peer support specialist. The facility has a 23-hour observation chair unit that will allow patients to stay up to 23 hours for observation, further assessment, and discharge planning, based on medical necessity.

- This service offers therapeutic interventions that assist the individual with coping and improving their functional skills to prevent hospitalization.
- Therapeutic interventions are designed to support an individual remaining in the community and to effect symptom reduction, risk-of-harm reduction, and/or safe transition of persons in acute crises to appropriate crisis stabilization and detoxification supports/services
- An immediate evaluation, triage, and access to acute mental health, developmental disability and/or substance abuse services
- Treatment and supports reduce the incidence of recurring crises
- Divert individuals from inpatient psychiatric services and incarceration

The Behavioral Health Urgent Care is available to provide services for individuals when...

- An initial assessment is needed to start services
- Experiencing an acute, immediate, non-medical crisis
- Has insufficient or severely limited resources or skills with which to cope with the immediate crisis
- Exhibits impairment of judgment and/or impulse control and/or cognitive/perceptual difficulties
- Is suffering from suicidal/homicidal ideations or psychosis
- Is under involuntary commitment due to mental health or substance abuse symptoms
- Seeking detox or placement into an inpatient facility

Insurance is not needed to access this service
