The Architect Selection Committee will review the data submitted and select the firms to interview. Notification will be sent to all firms advising them whether or not they have been selected for interviews by February 1, 2017. Interviews will be conducted between February 6 and February 17, 2017. Recommendations for some or all the selected architects are expected to be made at the March 10, 2017 meeting of the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education. We are hopeful that selected firms can start design immediately for the schematic design of 2017 and 2018 projects referenced in the bond approved schedule.
