This week's travels are taking us to many places as we continue our Second Grade Journey...

MATH...

Our focus continues to shine on **Geometry**. We will be discussing solid (3 D) shapes and their attributes (features) this week. Notice our vocabulary: faces, edges, vertices, angles, line segments, equalateral, quadrilateral, polygon...We will be able to: identify triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons, and cubes; recognize and draw shapes having specified attributes; partition a rectangle into rows and columns of same-sized squares.

CONTINUE to have your child practice addition/subtraction facts and count coins😊

LANGUAGE ARTS...

Our Reading Groups are completing the Dinosaur Unit and using our knowledge of "Non-Fiction Text Features". Ask your child to explain some of the text features we have learned about. We are in the midst of creating some special Technology Projects! Our little writers are composing the final copy of their Dinosaur Research Reports!
