MANDATORY GRADUATION REHEARSAL – Thurs, June 9, 2011, 6:30 p.m. LJVM COLISEUM

- 1. **Do not bring your cap & gown to rehearsal**. Report to LJVM Coliseum promptly at 6:00 p.m. (Please allow for traffic find your name on seat on the coliseum floor upon arrival)
- 2. **Parking:** Enter off University Pkwy at the LJVM Coliseum marquee. Once in the parking lot, take the first left into the "Mountain Dew" parking lot. When facing the coliseum from the "Mtn Dew" lot, the SENOR ENTRANCE will be on your far left. A senior entrance sign will be posted. Once inside you will be directed to the coliseum floor area. Names will be taped on chairs for rehearsal to help you find your seat.
- 3. Seating will be arranged similarly to Awards Day. A note will be taped to your seat if you owe fees, books, etc. ALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN THE EAST FORSYTH MAIN OFFICE BY FRIDAY, JUNE 10, AT NOON.
- 4. YOU MUST PRACTICE IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN GRADUATION. Practice will last approximately 1 ½ hours.

GRADUATION - SATURDAY, JUNE 11, 2011, 8:30 p.m.

- 1. **Arrive at the coliseum promptly at 7:30 p.m.** Go directly to your homeroom area and <u>stay in line</u> (your homeroom teacher will hold up a sign so you can find him/her). **Any senior not in assigned spot in homeroom line at 8:15 will be placed at the end of the line.**
- 2. **DO NOT WEAR YOUR CAP/GOWN INTO THE COLISEUM.** Carry your gown over your arm until inside the coliseum.
- 3. There is no place to store purses, cameras, etc. in the coliseum. Do not bring them in with you.
- 4. Wear dress clothes. Do not pin or tape anything to the outside of your cap or gown.
 - ♦ Ladies: Wear dresses or skirts. Do not wear pants, shorts, tennis shoes, flip flops/Birks.
 - Dress sandals with a heel are fine. It is preferred that shoes be a <u>dark color (gowns are navy)</u>. No colored hose.
 - ♦ Gentlemen: Wear dress slacks, shirt <u>and</u> a tie; dark socks and dress shoes. Do not wear shorts, tennis shoes or sandals.
 - ♦ NO SUNGLASSES OR CHEWING GUM ALLOWED AT AWARDS DAY OR GRADUATION!!!
- 5. When the procession begins—NO TALKING! Stay directly behind the senior or marshal in front of you, keeping an arms length distance. Junior Marshals will be placed throughout the line. Follow their lead in the lines, to and from the stage. Watch your Jr. Marshal so that you will know when to stand and proceed to the stage. You will also watch your Marshal to signal your row to be seated. Misbehavior of any kind will result in removal from the coliseum. DO NOT SKIP SEATS!
- 6. After all seniors have received their diploma cover, Ms. Gainey will declare you graduates. At that time, move your tassel to the right side of your cap.
- 7. After the ceremony, go directly to your homeroom teacher. You will then receive your diploma. You will exit from the same door in which you arrived to Mountain Dew lot
