3 Year Old PK

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The 3-year-old EC PreK classroom at Southwest serves children with delays in their development including speech, school readiness, social-emotional skills, and self help skills. We follow the North Carolina Foundations for Early Learning and Development, and we also focus on each child's IEP goals.

We start our day with breakfast in the classroom and use that time to work on communication, making choices, and independence. We spend time as a whole group during circle time completing our daily calendar, singing songs, and reading books. We have daily recess and return to the room for centers, which is time for child-directed activities. Small group activities also take place during this time to work on more individualized skills. After lunch we have rest time and then a snack before dismissal. We work hard to help our students learn the social and self help skills that they will need to be successful in the future.

Our goal is to help each child develop self-discipline to make good choices. Together, the home, school, and community share the responsibility for developing good citizens. Parents, teachers, and students must work together to maintain a safe learning environment. Southwest utilizes a Positive Behavior Intervention Support Program to recognize the positive contributions of students. Each teacher has a classroom discipline plan that informs students of classroom rules, consequences, and incentives. Southwest students are expected to be Safe, Outstanding, Accountable, and Respectful (SOAR) at school. We work to help our students understand appropriate behaviors through modeling and through positive reinforcement when they make a good choice.
