Did you know...

- NC law requires Tdap and Meningitis vaccine for all students entering the 7th grade
- Students not immunized **WILL BE EXCLUDED** from school on Sept. 24 until proof of immunization
- NC law requires Kindergarten Health Assessments for **ALL** students entering Kindergarten
- Students not having KHA/immunizations **WILL BE EXCLUDED** on Sept. 24 until those medical requirements are met
- Students of any grade level who are new to the public schools of North Carolina need a completed NC Health Assessment Transmittal Form

- Before June 13 and after Aug. 1 @ the Bulldog Health Center at Mineral Springs (including immunizations)
- On the Mobile Health Clinic – scheduled for the following dates and locations from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
