For the summer of 2011, Glenn High School will offer basic courses for a limited number of students. There will be four sessions of summer school. **The dates for summer school are July 6 - July 28.**

There will be a registration fee for summer school. Students will be required to pay \$50.00 for each ½ unit of credit. Students may earn a total of two credits. The registration fee (cash, personal check or money order) is to be collected at the time of registration for summer school classes. **There is no cost for seniors who need courses for graduation by June 30 or July 28, 2011.** There is a registration form attached to this letter for students who participate in the federal free and reduced lunch program or who have extenuating circumstances. Complete the forms provided with this letter and have your child return it to his/her school counselor no later than June 10, 2011.

- Students can only register for courses they have failed.
- Limited transportation will be provided. **(See Registration form.)**
- Only **regular level** courses will be taught.
- Registration ends June 10.
- **Students should verify their mailing address and phone numbers with their counselor to ensure mail delivery.**
- Enrollment is confirmed when students receive their schedules via US mail on or before July 2.
- Breakfast and lunch will NOT be provided.
- Students who drop or are dismissed from the program will **not** receive course credit.
- No exceptions will be made for vacations or any other situation that may arise.
- All regular school rules concerning dress code, headgear, electronic devices and cell phones etc., will be in effect. Any misbehavior will result in immediate dismissal from the Summer School program.
