As we are getting closer to the start of your child's senior year, the senior advisors wanted to check in with you as we are getting the year underway. We have all been extremely busy with the transition from PowerSchool Learning to Canvas as the main instructional delivery system for classes, but we know that there are still numerous questions that you are sure to have. Please understand that we are limited in the amount of answers that we have at this time, but we wanted to communicate what we do know.

E-mail information is sent through the student's school system e-mail as well as the parent e-mail on file. When I send an e-mail out, I will generally tweet that you should expect that communication. In years past, parents have thrown a picnic in the fall for the seniors. Due to the conditions regarding activities on campus, we are postponing this to the spring. Traditionally, the September photos (men's tuxedo and ladies' drapes) have been the yearbook photos. The senior advisors have nothing to do with these photographs. The cap and gown photos have traditionally been taken in December on Senior Day. This is also the day that the cap & gown orders, senior fees, announcements, group photos, and other senior needs have been taken care of.
