SENIOR DAY INFORMATION SESSION

Reminder: Participating in today's events and ordering announcements, cap + gown, etc. does not ensure graduation! There are **no refunds** on any items or fees if you don't graduate or don't choose to participate in graduation!

Class Day is Friday, May 24. This program celebrates the accomplishments of the Class of 2024. Scholarships and awards are presented at this program. (You have until Friday, May 10th at 3:45pm to forward any financial aid/scholarship information (emails) to your counselor or turn in any paper copies.) Each senior can have up to 4 family members attend that day.

Class Day Attire - This is a formal and dignified program, and we expect you to dress accordingly.

- **Gentlemen** should wear dress pants or nice khaki pants with belts, dress shirt (with or without tie) or collared shirt and dress shoes. Please have shirts tucked in. Follow dress code. No jeans, no shorts, no flip-flops, no tennis shoes, etc. Look nice!
- Ladies should wear a school appropriate dress or dressy pants outfit with dress shoes. Follow the dress codenothing revealing, tight, short, or without the appropriate straps. No flip-flops or jeans. Look nice!

<u>Cap and Gown Distribution</u>: Caps and gowns are distributed after the Class Day program on Friday, May 24. In order to receive your cap/gown package, you:

- Must have paid all debts owed to Reagan High School (you received a slip today to help you get started, but it is not the final debt list as other debts may occur). Be sure to check with the Media Center regarding items checked out or dues (calculators and books for class are understood to still be checked out on Class Day.)
- Must not be in danger of failing a class you need for graduation ("D-"/"F"). Make sure you stay on top of your grades/graduation requirements for the rest of the year!
- Must not have any debt with Jostens.

National Honor Society members should keep your dues and service hours current so you will be eligible to receive your cord. You will be able to pick up a cord when you get your cap and gown that will be yours to keep. See Mr. Mercer if you have questions.

Graduation Practice will be held at the LJVM Coliseum. We are waiting for information from the school system regarding times and dates for graduation practice. Students will be expected to be at the Coliseum and attendance will be taken.

Practice is required for any senior who plans to participate in the Graduation Ceremony – including January graduates. Practice usually lasts 1½ to 2 hours. Family members are not allowed at graduation practice. Be sure to ask employers for that time off.

You will get additional information regarding practice on **Thursday, May 23 at the Graduation Meeting (held from 1:35-3:40) at Reagan** – again, **this May meeting is mandatory** for all current seniors and those January graduates who are choosing to participate in graduation.

<u>Graduation</u> is <u>Sunday</u>, <u>June 9 at 8:00am at the Lawrence Joel Coliseum</u>. **Plan to arrive at the Coliseum around 7:00am.** At this moment, tickets are not required for admission. Seating is first come, first served.

Graduation Attire:

- **Gentlemen** should wear black, navy blue, or khaki dress pants (absolutely no shorts, jeans, cargo pants, or other casual pants), dress shoes (no flip-flops, Crocs, Hey Dudes, sneakers, slides, or other casual shoes), white or off-white dress shirt, and a tie or bowtie (required).
- Ladies should wear a dress, skirt & top, or dark dress pants and white/off-white top with dress shoes (no flip-flops, Crocs, Hey Dudes, sneakers, slides, or other casual shoes) Skirt/dress length should be no longer than the hem of the graduation gown. If it is longer, you will have to pin it up. You will be walking up and down many stairs, thus high heels are neither practical nor logical for this day. We highly recommend you to wear your planned shoes to practice.

- Please take photos with family and friends before the ceremony. Family members are not allowed backstage and you will not be allowed back into the Coliseum arena for socializing/photos. You will need to leave the Coliseum immediately after receiving your diploma as another school will be coming in for their time slot.

LifeTouch will take the photo of each of you receiving your diploma. You will receive more information about these pictures at Graduation Practice and be able to find these on your myLifeTouch account.

<u>3rd Quarter Honor Roll Incentive:</u> If you make the 1st semester honor roll (3.0 <u>unweighted</u> with no score below a C), you will be eligible to attend a senior only event during a school day. More information to come. January graduates are excluded from the event.

<u>Graduation Speaker Auditions:</u> We are looking for seniors to audition to speak at graduation. We will have a meeting in Mr. McAbee's room (room 629) on <u>Monday, April 29 at 3:45 or Tuesday, April 30 at 8:15</u> for all interested seniors. At this meeting, you will be provided with the criteria for auditions. Auditions will be on <u>Tuesday, May 21 at 4:00</u> in room 629. Your final speech must be ready on that day. You will be presenting before a selection panel, so be prepared to give it your best.
