

Senior Day Information

Senior Day will take place on **Friday, October 23rd**. Every senior needs to participate on this day. To give you a heads up about the day's activities and expenses, here are the highlights:

You are going to receive an e-mail soon with information about signing up for a time for Senior Day. Please take into consideration transportation concerns when you choose your time. You might want to start arranging with friends to make it to campus. There are five time periods for you to choose. There will be approximately 110 spots in each time period.

- 8:00-9:00
- 9:30-10:30
- 11:00-12:00
- 1:00-2:00
- 2:30-3:30

During that hour, the senior will rotate through 4 stations.

1. Senior yearbook photos. Every senior will be getting their picture taken, even if you do not order photos. You will be receiving a **separate e-mail** with the LifeTouch order form.
 - Guys should wear a t-shirt so they can put the tuxedo shirt and coat over it.
 - Ladies should wear a cami so they can put on the drape for the picture. You may choose to wear a necklace as an accessory.
2. Seniors will be placing their cap and gown order through Jostens. You will be getting a **separate e-mail** with the Jostens catalog. While Jostens also offers additional items (invitations, generic senior apparel, etc.) every senior is to order a cap and gown.
3. Payment of the senior fees and verifying the spelling of your name for the diploma. Every student will verify their name's accuracy, but only those who have not paid their senior fees online will need to bring the fee payment. Senior fees are \$30 this year, but those who pay online will only pay \$25 (to offset the service charge). Senior fees are used for Class Day costs (including printing of programs), graduation costs (including security, programs, and other costs not covered by the school system), class gift contribution, and other senior event costs that occur during the year.
4. All seniors will participate in an information session with Student Services.

We will be scheduling cap and gown photos in the future. They will not be taken on October 23rd.

PLEASE – be on the lookout for future e-mails. Students should check their school e-mail frequently to keep up with information regarding this important event. These communications will contain additional information about the specific stations. Hopefully
