At this time all the classroom is being done online. It can be taken at any high school. You are then sent back to your school for in-car.

Eye checks and payment of the \$45 fee will be scheduled after the class, and announced by NC Driving School. This can be done at any location. Do not arrive earlier than 3:45, and will end at 4:30.

Students are normally driven within 90 days, with the oldest students called first.

Students must be at least 14 and ½ years of age.

The classroom phase is 30 hours.(Usually 3 hours after school for 10 days) The Summer classroom is usually 8-12 AM, Monday-Thursday for 2 weeks.

The students will receive 6 hours of in-car instruction. This will be done with 2 students. This is usually done within 4 days, 3-4 hours a day.

All Covid protocols will be observed. Masks must be worn, temperature taken, and a parent signs a screening form. All controls will be disinfected between drivers.
