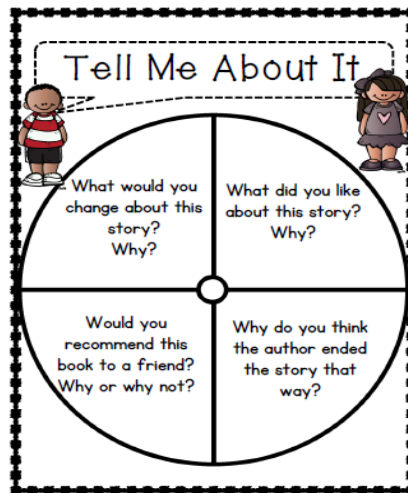

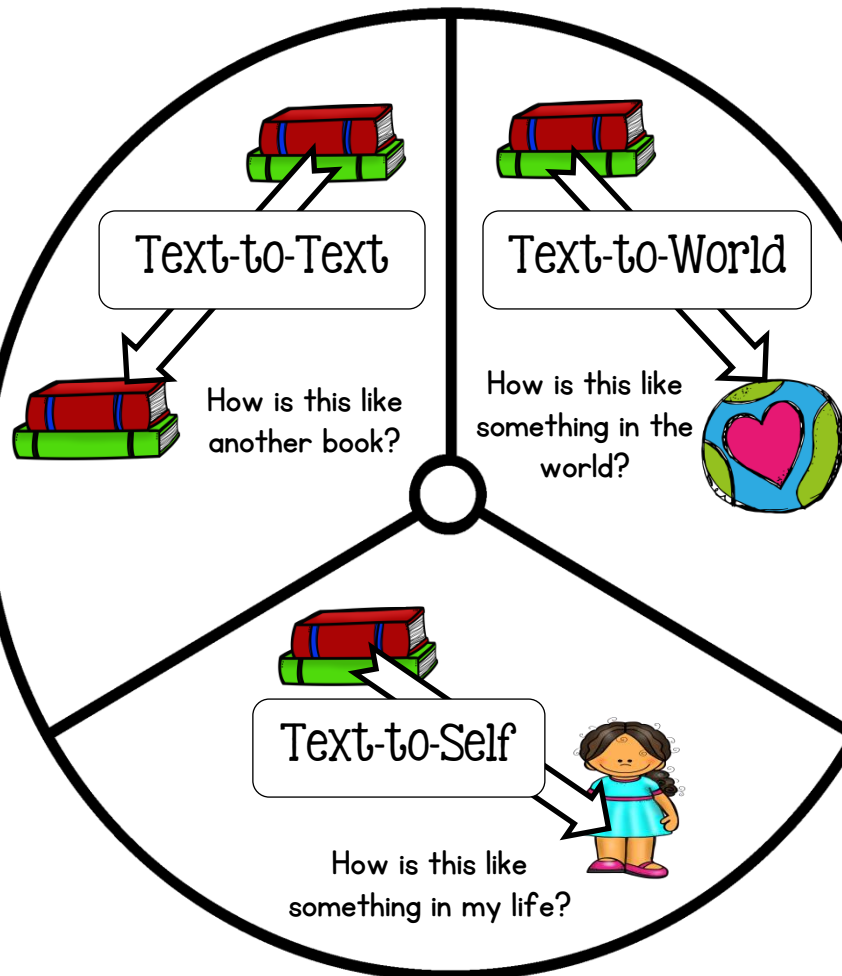

# Helpful Hints

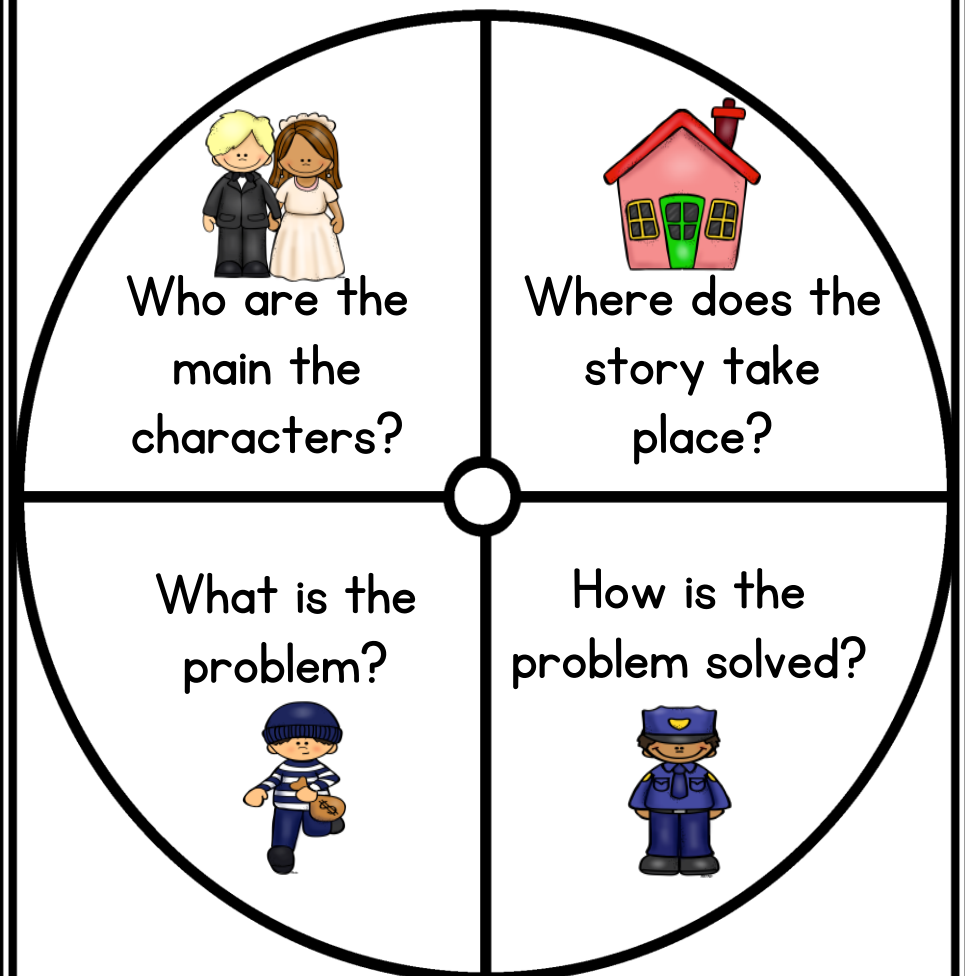

3. Use these in small or whole groups to “spice” up your reading comprehension!



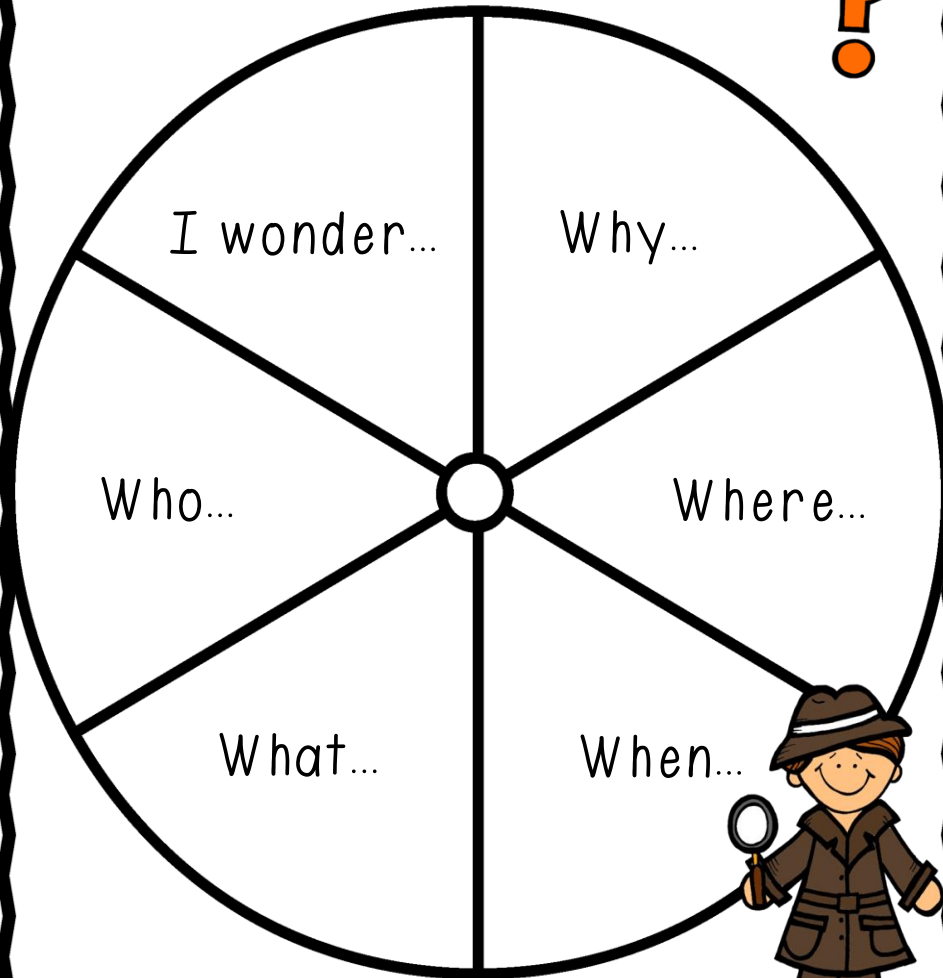
