

Teacher Info

This freebie is a great word work activity for students to practice their lower case letters! There is a small bee in the upper left corner of each card. This should help with the direction of commonly confused letters, such as b/d. The font chosen aligns with the font used in Fundations programs (the most common font students will come across when reading).


I've included the letter q alone, and with it's "buddy" u. You can choose which you want students to use!


Haven't taught all of the letters yet? Just choose the ones students already know!


Directions

Students can play with a partner or small group.

Place all of the cards in a bowl. Taking turns, one student picks one card out of the bowl. That student tells the letter name and the letter sound of that letter to the group. If they are correct, they keep the card. If not, the card goes back into the bowl. For each correct answer, students must trace and write that letter on their worksheet. If a student picks a "buzz" card, they lose a turn. The game is over when they have chosen all of the letters. The students with the most letters at the end wins!
