<p>Exams and EOCs:</p>	<p>Exam and End of Course Testing schedules</p> <p>End-of-Course: Biology, English II, NC Math 1 and NC Math 3</p> <p>Students enrolled in Biology, English II, NC Math 1 and NC Math 3 shall participate in the End-of-Course (EOC) online test at the end of the course. Your student will receive an achievement level and converted 100-pt scale score which will count for 20% of their final course grades*.</p> <p><i>We are testing each morning beginning at 8:55 am and until our last EOC concludes (usually around 12:15, but can vary). It is very important that during this time we have a secure testing environment for all students in the building, this means limited movement, no intercom announcements, and no calling into rooms. Students are expected to stay in their assigned final exam or EOC room for the entirety of the testing</i></p>

	<p><i>period. If parents need to pick up students during the day we are asking that they do so once the testing window has concluded (specifically after 12:15 pm each day). <p>Loose Ends:</p>	<p><u>Seniors</u> - please return everything you have checked out to the Media Center as soon as you no longer need it.
