## WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING TO MY SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT?

- Valid ID (Parent or Legal Guardian)
- Child's original birth certificate
- Child's School Entry Health Form with up-to-date immunizations
- Custody papers, if applicable
- Proof of residency
  - deed, lease or mortgage statement
  - current utility bill (water, electricity, or gas)
