Dear Parent/Guardian:

I hope the school year has started successfully for you and your student(s). There is an annual requirement to notify parents/families of students attending a school identified as TSI-CU, Targeted Support & Improvement-Consistently Underperforming. As stated in the "Every Student Succeeds Act" (ESSA) Section 1111(c)(4)(D)(i), North Carolina was required to identify schools for comprehensive support and improvement. The list of identified schools was determined based on the 2020-2021 End of Grade/Course assessments.

TSI-CU schools in North Carolina are those that have one or more of the same subgroups underperforming for the most recent year and previous year. The intent of this opportunity is to improve educational outcomes for all students, close achievement gaps, increase equity, and improve the quality of instruction.

As a TSI-CU school, we are required to develop a comprehensive plan with parent, family, and community input that specifically addresses how the school will improve student achievement. The district will support and monitor the progress of our school.

The comprehensive plan will address the following areas:

- We will provide targeted interventions during core instruction to students who show need through various data collection points
- Our certified teachers will provide, at minimum of two days per week, either before or after school tutoring in the area of remedial services to students
- All staff will be trained in Restorative Practices to support our new Code of Character, Conduct and Support

Our students need to experience higher achievement levels, and it will require hard work on the part of staff, students, and families. Here are some ways we can work together:
