Tardy Policy 2012-2013

Effective February 11, 2013

It is our goal to provide positive learning environments for all students. Students must be in class on time to maximize instruction and to limit classroom interruptions. Students need to arrive to each class and school on time. Students have five minutes between class changes giving ample time to go from one class to the next. According to board policy, ten unexcused tardies in a class equal an unexcused absence.

Following are consequences for students who are tardy to class:

- 1st Tardy-Warning
- 2nd Tardy-Warning and Parent Phone Call
- 3rd Tardy-Assigned to After/Before School Detention
- 4th Tardy-Assigned to After/Before School Detention and parent phone call
- 5th Tardy-Assigned to Period Detention
- 6th Tardy-Assigned to Period Detention and parent contact
- 7th Tardy-Assigned to In-School Suspension
- 8th Tardy + -Parent phone call and referral to School Social Worker

*Students must attend the assigned detention.

Before School Detention is 7:45 – 8:45

After School Detention is 3:45 – 4:45

Students/Guardians must arrange for their own transportation.

*Students assigned to detention but choose not to come will be assigned to In-School Suspension.
