

Environment: everything that surrounds living things and affects growth and health; the natural world.



Civilization: an advanced stage of development of a society as judged by a system of government and laws, written language, and keeping written records.



Society: all the members of a community or group.



Interaction: action between people or things having an effect on each other.



Source: something that supplies information such as a book or person.



Perspective: how one person sees or understands something.



Economics: the study of how things are made, distributed (shared), and consumed (used).



Government: group of people who make and enforce laws for a country or area.



Citizen: person who has the legal right to live in an area such as a country, state or city.
