

## MLA Bibliography Format:

1. Entries should be in alphabetical order by author's last name.
2. Double space paper.
3. Head your paper Works Cited. Do not underline or use quotations.
4. Each line after the first line of an entry should be indented.
5. Do not skip a space between entries.
6. See below for a sample.

### Book:

Author(s). Title of Book. Place of Publication: Publisher, Year of Publication.

### Encyclopedia:

"Title of Article." Title of Encyclopedia. Year ed.

### Web Site:

Author(s). Name of Page. Date of Posting/Revision. Name of institution/organization affiliated with the site. Date of Access <electronic address>.
